ELECTRIC DIGITAL 2.2 LITERS KETTLE

Please read this manual carefully and retain for future references.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

1. Read Carefully: Please carefully read these operation instructions before connecting your kettle to the power supply to avoid damage due to incorrect use.
2. Prevent Mishaps: Incorrect operation and improper handling can lead to faults in the kettle and injuries to the user.
3. Household Use Only: The kettle is designed for household use only.
4. Unplug When Not in Use: Always unplug the kettle from the power supply when not in use.
5. Protect from Moisture: Keep the base unit away from damp areas and protect it from splashes.
6. Avoid Immersion: Do not immerse the kettle, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
7. Check for Damage: Do not operate the kettle if the cord or plug show signs of damage, or if it has fallen or been otherwise damaged.
8. Prevent Damage to Cord: Ensure that the cord does not hang over sharp edges and keep it away from hot surfaces.
9. Safe Unplugging: Only pull the plug out of the power supply by the plug itself, not by the cord.
10. Stable Placement: Place the kettle on a stable surface, away from hot objects such as hotplates... Do not place it under curtains.
11. Supervision During Use: Never leave the kettle unattended during use.
12. Child Safety: Children should never use electrical domestic appliances unsupervised.
13. Base Unit Use: Use the kettle only with the supplied base unit and do not use the base unit for any other purposes.
14. Avoid Operation Off Base: Never remove the kettle from its base unit while in operation. Switch it off first.
15. Proper Lid Closure: Ensure the lid is properly closed before switching on. Failure to do so may prevent the kettle from switching off automatically, leading to potential overflow of hot water.
16. Water Heating Only: The kettle is for heating water only and is not to be used for any other liquids.

BEFORE FIRST USE

1. Remove Packing Materials: Remove all packing materials from the kettle before use.
2. Check Voltage: Before connecting the kettle, ensure that the voltage indicated on the rating label corresponds to the mains voltage in your home.
3. Initial Boiling: Fill the kettle with cool water up to the "MAX" mark and boil it. Empty the kettle and now it is ready for use.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

FILLING

1. Kettle Preparation: Remove the kettle from the base unit.
2. Water Filling Options: Water can be filled into the kettle either via the spout or by opening the lid, facilitated by pressing the lid release button.
3. Optimal Filling: It is advised to fill the kettle with a minimum of 1 liter of water to prevent it from running dry during operation.
4. Fill to "MAX" Mark: Ensure water is filled only up to the "MAX" mark to prevent spillage during the boiling process.

SWITCHING ON

1. Preparation: After filling the kettle with water, place it securely on the base unit.
2. Power Connection: Connect the plug to the power supply and toggle the On/Off switch downwards. The kettle will commence operation, indicated by the illumination of the indicator light.

SWITCHING OFF

- Automatic Shut-Off: Upon reaching boiling point, the kettle will automatically switch off, indicated by the extinguishing of the indicator light.
- Safety System: Note that the kettle features a safety system which automatically switches off the heating element if the kettle is inadvertently activated when empty or if it boils dry. In such instances, allow the kettle to cool down completely before refilling with water.

CARE AND CLEANING

1. Safety Precautions: Always disconnect the plug from the power supply and allow the kettle to cool down entirely before cleaning.
2. Cleaning Procedure: Use a soft damp cloth to clean the exterior of the kettle and the base unit, followed by wiping with a dry cloth. Avoid using scouring materials.

STORAGE

Cord Management: The kettle's cord can be neatly wound into the base unit, which features a cord storage compartment for convenience.
